





DRIET HIS LUKT UT BENGUET STATE UNIVERSITY BOKOD CAMPUS Benguet School of Arts and Trades (BSAT) 1969–2002

The Benguet School of Arts and Trades (BSAT) was established and enacted into law on June 21, 1969 under Republic Act 5918 through House Bill 12400 authored by then Congressman Atty. Andres Acop Cosalan, Sr. of Baguio-Benguet Congressional District. BSAT was then under the umbrella of the Department of Education and Culture under the administration of the defunct Bureau of Vocational Education (BVE) which was then a major component of the Department of Education and Culture.

The act empowered the Secretary of Education to organize the said school and to acquire by purchase though grant or donation the school site in Binejayeng, Ambangeg, Daklan, Bokod, Benguet. With the appropriated fund of Php 77,053.00, the acquisition of the school site within 1969-1970 was made possible through the generosity of then Baltazar Fernando and Victorina Lamsis- Fernando who donated the whole land area for the school site.

Eventually, on September 18, 2003, Proclamation no. 473 was made by President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo for the reservation of the eighty-six thousand three hundred twenty-three (86, 323) square meters for School Site purposes of the Benguet School of Arts and Trades, Lot 2826, CAD-932-D, case 4, situated at Ambangeg, Daclan, Bokod, Benguet, Island of Luzon. This was done through the initiative of then Supt. Albert B. Panangon.

The operation of the school started in June 1972 with two programs: the Four-Year Secondary Trade and the Two-year Trade Technical curricula headed by the Vocational Schools Superintendent (Supt.) Hipolito B. Pacis.

On the enrichment of the curricular offerings, Supt. Pacis requested the Secretary of Education and culture on June 02, 1975, the offering of the four-year Technical Education Curriculum leading to the Degree, Bachelor of Science in Industrial Education (BSIE) with emphasis on Practical Arts and Industrial Arts effective school year 1975-1976 and was approved on August 13, 1976. In like manner, through DEC's Department Order no. 78, s.1975 on August 08, 1975, the fouryear Technical Education curriculum leading to the degree of Bachelor of Science in Industrial Technology (BSIT) was offered in BSAT effective on the first semester of the School Year 1975-1976. BSAT was one of the selected Trade-Technical schools authorized by the DEC to offer programs in the post-secondary level to prepare graduates/students for supervisory and management position in industries. The offering of these programs started during the school-year 1976-1977, but all students were enrolled in the BSIE. It was during the school year 1977-1978 that there were enrollees to the two-degree programs. The Two-Year Trade Technical was laddered to the BSIE and the BSIT programs. This made the pioneer graduates of the BSIE graduated in 1978 and first graduates of the BSIT in 1979.


With the implementing guidelines of the integration law, the Commission on Higher Education's (CHED) memorandum No. 27 series 2000, BSAT was integrated to Benguet State University on January 1, 2001 and is now Benguet State University- Bokod Campus. In June 2002, the Bachelor of Elementary Education (BEE) was offered and had its first graduation on April 4, 2006.

The memorandum of agreement on the phase out of high school was signed in 2016, thus the BSU-Bokod Campus no longer offer secondary education and had its last high school graduates on April 18, 2015. Now, the BSU-Bokod offers ten Undergraduate Degree Programs: Bachelor of Technical-Vocational Teacher Education; Bachelor of Technology and Livelihood Education; Bachelor of Elementary Education; Bachelor of Culture and Arts Education; Bachelor of Industrial Technology; and Bachelor of Science in Entrepreneurship, Bachelor of Secondary Education, Bachelor in Public Administration, Bachelor of Science in Information Technology and Bachelor of Science in Criminology. The campus also offers three master's degree programs and one doctorate program.

Hipolito Pacis became the first Superintendent from June 1972 to 1975. Patrick Umayat was also installed as the Superintendent from 1976 – 1979 and 1985 – 1993. On January 28, 1980 to 1984, Suelto E. Tello was assigned by the Directorate as Vocational Administrator Officer-in-Charge. Mr. Estanislao M. Tagtag likewise became the Officer-in-Charge in 1984-1985 while Mr. Balner M. Damoslog was the Officer-in-Charge from 1993 to 1994. Dr. Albert B. Panangon came in as school superintendent on June 1,1994 until September 11, 2011. Engr. Edgar Mencio Molintas was designated as Executive Dean on September 12, 2011 until July 31, 2021, and Dr. Samuel Salay Poliden served as the Executive Dean from August 1, 2021- July 31, 2022.

Dr. Poliden spearheaded the creation of the three (3) colleges: College of Applied Technology with the first Dean, Mrs. Violeta Basco Bugtong, College of Education with the first Dean, Dr. Chester Batan Esnara, and College of Business Administration and Management with the first Dean, Mr. Federico Binaldo Basco. The College of Criminal Justice Education was also created along with the offering or the BS Criminology in 2022 with Mr. Joel Humakay Nehyeban as the first Dean.

At present, BSU Bokod Campus is headed by Dr. Shakira Basatan Herman as Executive Dean effective August 1, 2022 with Cherry Sinas Tolano as the Associate Executive Dean. Currently there are 20 non-teaching employees and 30 faculty members who are working for the development of the campus and the studentry.
