### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

### 1. APPLICANTS

Applicants, regardless of age, sex or gender, civil status, physical deformity, political affiliation, race, religion, ethnicity or type of secondary education completed may submit application for admission subject to the duly approved admission requirements:

- a. Senior High School Graduates;
- b. Grade 12 as of application period (currently enrolled as Grade 12);
- c. ALS/PEPT Completers eligible for college admissions
- d. Transferees; and
- e. Graduates of Non-Education Degree Program

### 2. GRADES

All CTE degree programs require a licensure examination before its professional practice, hence the General Weighted Average (GWA) must be 86% or better and grades for English, Math and Science must be 86% or better.

## 3. QUOTA REQUIREMENT AND AVAILABILITY OF SLOTS

The total number of students to be admitted is 50.
