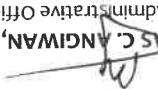
WHEREAS, consonant to the provisions of R.A 9184, the **BENGUET STATE UNIVERSITY** posted an Invitation to Bid for the project: **2025-01 Procurement of Various Information Technology (IT) Equipment BSU Academic Affairs Office** composed of three (3) items, in the PhilGEPS, agency website and four (4) conspicuous places continuously starting on January 23, 2025;

WHEREAS, in response to the invitation Nine, (9) firms through their representatives namely: Arjelon Enterprises and Trading Corporation; MSIT Solutions, Inc.; Officetech General Merchandise; Joneco Tech Marketing Corporation; Tarlac MAC Enterprises Inc.; Hexacom Enterprises; Inforworx Inc.; AEC Technoworld and TSS Corporation submitted their bids on the date, time, and place specified in the invitation;

WHEREAS, upon checking the legal, technical and financial documents submitted by the bidders, using the “pass/fail” criteria, only four (4) bidders were declared eligible. Thus, their financial offers were opened. See table below.

WHEREAS, the bid of MSIT Solutions, Inc. (Michael Mata) for item 1 under the project (IB NO. 2025-01), has been determined by the Bid and Awards Committee to be the 1st Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) and recommended for post-qualification with the assistance of the Technical Working Group (TWG) and the end-user.

WHEREAS, the reports of the TWG indicate that the 1st (LCB) MSIT Solution, Inc. (Michael Mata) was non-compliant with the required technical specifications, particularly on 64 GB ROM, CPU A72x2 + A53x4, a maximum of 45 touch points, and two RJ45 ports. Their offer did not meet the minimum requirements set by the University. Furthermore, other findings revealed the absence of “similar projects” for verification and validation of comparable items, such as interactive boards.

WHEREAS, upon verifications and validations, the BAC declared the bid of MSIT Solution, Inc. (Michael Mata) as post disqualified.

WHEREAS, notice of post-disqualification was issued to MSIT Solution, Inc. (Michael Mata) and was acknowledged on March 12, 2025, but did not file its motion for reconsideration within the three-day reglementary period.

WHEREAS, the bid of Jonesco Tech Marketing Corporation (Alex J. Villareal) for the 18 units Interactive Flat Smart TV, 75” ,4K Ultra HD, listed as item 1 under the project (IB NO. 2025-01), has been determined by the Bid and Awards Committee to be the 2nd Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) and recommended for post-qualification, with the assistance of the Technical Working Group (TWG) and the end-user.

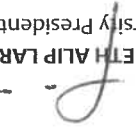
WHEREAS, after validation and verification, the bid of herein SUPPLIER was found to have passed all the requirements and conditions specified in the Bidding Documents for the item no.2 (18 units Interactive Flat Smart TV, 75” ,4K Ultra HD) of the Project. Under **BAC Resolution Number 2025-297A** the bid was determined as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) with a recommendation for award to herein SUPPLIER;

WHEREAS, the **BENGUET STATE UNIVERSITY** accepted the Bid by the Supplier for the supply of those identified goods and services in the sum of **Two Million Three Hundred Forty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Pesos Only (Php 2,346,300.00)** hereinafter called the “Contract Price” vis-à-vis the approved Budget for the Contract for the project of **Two Million Seven Hundred Thousand Pesos Only (Php 2,700,000.00)**;

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz.:
 - a. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. Schedule of Requirements;
 - ii. Technical Specifications;
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
 - iv. Supplemental bid bulletin, if any
 - b. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statement submitted; Bid form, including all documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and

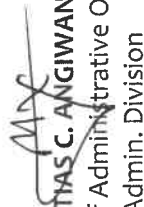
all other documents submitted (e.g. Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;

- c. Performance Security;
 - d. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's *conforme* thereto; and
 - e. Other Contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity in the PBDs. The **Winning bidder agrees that additional documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.**
3. In consideration of the sum of One Million Two Million Three Hundred Forty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Pesos Only (PhP 2,346,300.00), or such other sums as may be ascertained, **Joneco Tech Marketing Corporation** (Alex J. Villareal) agrees to supply and deliver particularly **item no.2** (18 units Interactive Flat Smart TV, 75", 4K Ultra HD) of the project in accordance with its Bid.
4. That the delivery period will be **Sixty (60)** calendar days; counted from the supplier's receipt of the Notice to Proceed;
5. The Benguet State University agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.
