This Contract made and entered into this 12th day of September 2025 by and between:

BENGUET STATE UNIVERSITY, a chartered public educational institution of higher learning, established and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines having office at La Trinidad, Benguet, herein referred to as **BSU** and represented by its President, **DR. KENNETH ALIP LARUAN**;

And

MARK ASIONG, doing business under the style and name **DKLR ENTERPRISE**, a business entity duly organized and existing in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal address at No. 350 Hallelujah Building, Magsaysay Avenue, Lower Magsaysay, Baguio City, herein referred to as the **“SUPPLIER”**.

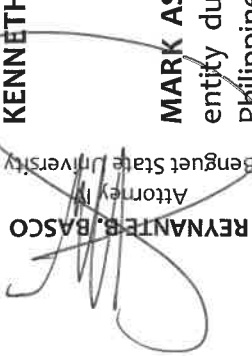
WHEREAS, consonant to the provisions of R.A 9184, the **BENGUET STATE UNIVERSITY** posted an Invitation to Bid for the project: **IB No. 2025-19A Procurement of Cultural and Sports Uniforms** in the PhilGEPS, agency website and four (4) conspicuous places continuously starting on August 19, 2025 to August 27, 2025;

WHEREAS, in response to the Invitation, six (6) bidders submitted their bids on the date, time, and place specified in the invitation. These are **AJQ DIGITAL PRINTING** (Ms. Elizabeth G. Quine), **BOOGS SPORTSWEAR AND FASHION DESIGN, ZHUJAR MFG. INC.** (Ms. Nimpha E. Basa), **CATDAVES TAILORING AND SPORTSWEAR SHOP** (Ms. Melodee C. Aquino), **J.SO GARMENTS TRADING** (Mr. Manuel D. Cabrera Jr.) and **DKLR ENTERPRISE** (Mr. Mark T. Asiong).

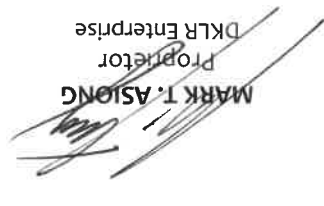
WHEREAS, after preliminary examination, the bid of **DKLR ENTERPRISE** (Mr. Mark T. Asiong) was found to be the “Lowest Calculated Bid” for the Project and the same was subjected to post-qualification;

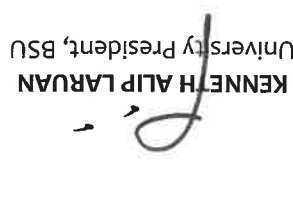
WHEREAS, after validation and verification, the bid of herein **SUPPLIER** was found to have passed all the requirements and conditions specified in the Bidding Documents for the indicated items in the Project. Under **BAC Resolution Number 2025-1001** the bid was determined as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) with a recommendation for award to herein **SUPPLIER**;

WHEREAS, the **BENGUET STATE UNIVERSITY** accepted a Bid by the Supplier for the supply of those identified goods and services in the sum of **Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos Only (Php 950,000.00)** hereinafter called the “Contract Price” vis-à-vis the approved Budget

for the Contract for the project of One Million Three Hundred Twenty Thousand Pesos Only (PhP1,320,000.00);

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz.:

a. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);

- i. Schedule of Requirements;
- ii. Technical Specifications;
- iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
- iv. Supplemental bid bulletin, if any

- b. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statement submitted; Bid form, including all documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g. Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;

c. Performance Security;

d. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and

- e. Other Contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity in the PBDs. Winning bidders agrees that additional documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.

3. In consideration of the sum of **Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php 950,000.00)** or such other sums as may be ascertained, **DKLR Enterprise (Mark T. Asiong)** agrees to supply and deliver the Cultural and Sports Uniforms in accordance with his Bid.

4. That the delivery period will be **Twenty (20)** calendar days; counted from the supplier's receipt of the Notice to Proceed;

5. The Benguet State University agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.

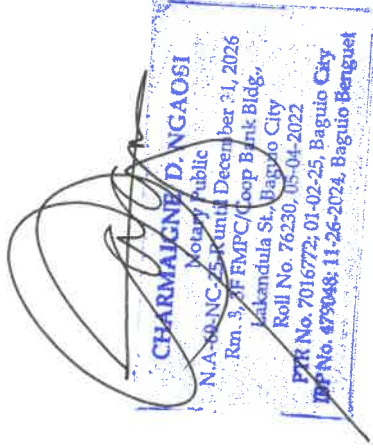
