



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This Contract made and entered into this 23rd day of December 2025 by and between:

BENGUET STATE UNIVERSITY, a chartered public educational institution of higher learning, established and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines having office at La Trinidad, Benguet, herein referred to as **BSU** and represented by its President, **DR. KENNETH ALIP LARUAN**;

-and-

MR. THOMAS C. SADDUL proprietor of **DIGITAL SOFTWARE TECHNOLOGY CONSULTANCY**, with business address at Number 7 Burgos Street, Centro 8, Tuguegarao City, Cagayan herein referred to as the **“SUPPLIER”**.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, consonant to the provisions of R.A 9184, the **BENGUET STATE UNIVERSITY** through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) invited the supplier to submit proposal for the project: RFQ 2025-1722 1 lot Upgrading of the Student Information and Accounting System (SIAS) of Benguet State University on December 11, 2025;

WHEREAS, in response to the invitation, Mr. Thomas C. Saddul, proprietor Digital Software Technology Consultancy, submitted his quotation before the scheduled submission at 5:00PM of December 16, 2025;

WHEREAS, after checking of the eligibility requirements and financial proposal submitted by the supplier, the offer was declared as passed. Having determined that the supplier passed all the required documents and the financial offer is within the approved budget for the contract, the offer was subjected to post qualification;

WHEREAS, after careful examination and verification, the offer of the herein **SUPPLIER** was found to have passed all the requirements and conditions specified in the request for quotation for the project. Under **BAC Resolution Number 2025-1568**, the quotation was declared as the Single Calculated and Responsive Quotation (SCRQ) with a recommendation for award of the project to herein **SUPPLIER**;

WHEREAS, the **BENGUET STATE UNIVERSITY** has accepted the offer of the Supplier for the supply of those goods and services in the sum of **Ten Million Pesos Only (Php. 10,000,000.00)** called the “Contract Price” vis-à-vis the approved

Budget for the Contract of Ten Million Pesos Only (Php. 10,000,000.00). The funding source of the contract is from 2025-GAA Capital Outlay;

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:


1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz.:
 - a. Invitation to submit proposal indicating the following:
 - i. Schedule of Requirements; and
 - ii. Technical Specifications including the annexes
 - b. Winning bidder's quotation, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statement submitted, including all documents/statements as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g. Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the project), including corrections to the quotation, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;
 - c. Performance Security;
 - d. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's *conforme* thereto; and
 - e. Other Contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. **The bidder agrees that additional documents or information that are subsequently prescribed and/or required for submission by the GPBB after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.**


3. In consideration of the sum of **Ten Million Pesos Only (Php. 10,000,000.00)**, or such other sums as may be ascertained, **Mr. Thomas C. Saddul (Digital Software Technology Consultancy)** agrees to supply, deliver, install and commission the upgraded and customized Student Information and Accounting System (SIAS) in accordance with his quotation.

4. Payment shall be made in three (3) milestone-based tranches, as follows:
- a. **40%** of the contract amount shall be released upon successful completion of system installation, configuration, and full data migration, as certified by the Office of the University Registrar (OUR) and the Information and Communication Technology (ICT).
 - b. **30%** shall be released upon verification that the system is capable of generating reports as specified in the deliverables:




The remaining 30% shall be released upon successful execution of one complete operational cycle, covering student admission, scheduling, and the printing of Certificates of Enrollment, as validated by the Office of the University Registrar (OUR) and the Information and Communication Technology (ICT).
- d. A 10% retention fee shall be deducted per payment tranche.

5. That the contract duration will be **Fifteen (15)** months divided in to three (3) phases; counted from the supplier's receipt of the Notice to Proceed;

6. The supplier warrants compliances compliance with the provisions of RA 10173 or the Data Privacy Act of 2012, thus providing the proof of compliance i.e. certificate of registration or equivalent document before the implementation of this contract;
7. The supplier/ service provider shall provide comprehensive after- sales support to ensure the effective operation sustainability of the upgraded SIAS;
- a. Warranty and Maintenance;
 - The service level must be 99.99%. The supplier must shall provide notice before conducting system maintenance
 - All system downtime must be documented, and appropriate reports must be given to the end-users
 - Data remains 100% ownership of the University and not by the Supplier
 - b. Minimum of ten (10) years warranty on software modules, including free updates and patches;
 - c. Preventive maintenance and corrective support for both hardware and software components;
 - d. Provide Technical Support;
 - e. 24/7 help desk support accessible via phone, email, or ticketing system;

- f. On-site technical assistance within 24-hours-3 days for critical issues affecting operations;
- g. System updates and compliance;
- h. Regular delivery of system upgrades aligned with CHED, UNIFAST, and other regulatory requirements;
- i. Lifecycle support;
- j. Commitment to provide free cloud server hosting for ten (10) years;
- k. Assistance in data migration, back up, and recovery protocols


8. The Benguet State University agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the project.






